Terms And Conditions:-

- (1) After bid lock bidder should have to submit hard copy of Bid Document in the office of Executive Engineer, PWD, NWCMC, Nanded. on or before dated 19/07/2018 upto 15:00.
- (2) Bidder shall attach the following document with their bid.
 - (a) Registration copy of GST.
 - (b) if more than 10 labors are required to complete the work , then it is the responsibility of the contractor to submit EPF and ESI of labor.
 - (c) scan copy / Xerox copy of EMD.
- (3) As per GR.सीएटी2017/प्र.क्र8/इमा-2 दि. 12.04.2017 bidder has to submit performance security for below tenders (i.e. unbalanced tenders) in the form of DD/FDR/Bank Guarantee separately in the Envelop No. 2.
- (4) Bill of work will be processed after getting Third Party Technical Audit Report from Government Agency.
- (5) Bidder shall provide cost of tender document and EMD through online payment gateway.
- (6) Successful bidder shall have to provide Insurance Policy from Government Insurance Company.
- (7) The Municipal Commissioner reserves rights to reject or accept any or all tenders

Other Conditions:

1. Qualification of the Bidder

A) All bidders shall provide in Section 2, Forms of Bid and Qualification Information, a preliminary description of the proposed work method and schedule, including drawings and charts, as necessary. The proposed methodology should include programmer of construction backed with equipment planning and deployment duly supported with broad calculations and quality assurance procedures proposed to be adopted justifying their capability of execution and completion of work as per technical specifications, within stipulated period of completion.

B) All bidders shall include the following information and documents with their bids in Section 2.

- (w) Copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration under partnership or companies Act and principal place of business, written power of attorney of the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder ;
- (x) Total monetary value of construction work performed for each of the last five years (i.e. 13-14 to 17-18)
- (y) Experience in works of a similar nature and size for each of the last five years (i.e. 13-14 to 17-18) and details of works underway or contractually committed and clients who may be contacted for further information on those contracts ;
- (z) Major items of construction equipment proposed to carry out the Contract.
- (e) Qualifications and experience of key site management and technical personnel proposed for contract;
- (f) Reports on the financial standing of the Bidder, such as profit and loss statements and auditor's reports for the past five years (i.e. 13-14 to 17-18)
- (g) Evidence of access to line(s) of credit and availability of other financial resources facilities (10% of contract value) certified by the Bankers. (Not more than 3 months old) (Not required for works costing less than Rs.5 Crores);
- (h) Undertaking that the bidder will be able to invest a minimum cash upto 25% of contract value of work during implementation of work
- (i) Authority to seek references from the Bidder's bankers ;
- (j) Information regarding any litigation, current or during the last five years (i.e. 13-14 to 17-18), in which the Bidder is involved, the parties concerned and disputed amount ;
- (k) Proposals for subcontracting components of the Works amounting to more than 10 percent of the Bid Price (for each, the qualifications and experience of the identified sub contractor in the relevant field should be annexed); and
- (n) The proposed methodology and programme of construction, backed with equipment planning and deployment, duly supported with broad calculations and quality control procedures proposed to be adopted, justifying their capability of execution and completion of the work as per technical specifications within the stipulated period of completion as per milestones.

2. Bids from Joint ventures are Acceptable.

3. A. To qualify for award of the contract, each bidder in its name should have in the last five years (i.e. 13-14 to 17-18) as referred to in Appendix.

- (e) Achieved a Maximum annual financial turnover (in all classes of civil engineering construction works only) Rs. 5.93 Cr in any one year (usually not less than two and a half times the estimated annual payments under the contract);
- (f) Satisfactorily completed (not less than 90% of contract value), as a prime contractor (or as a nominated subcontractor, where the subcontract involved execution of "all main items of work described in the bid document, provided further that all other qualification criteria are satisfied) at least one similar work of value not less than Rs. 1.19 Cr (*usually not less than 50% of estimated value of contract*);
- (e) Executed in anyone year, the minimum quantities of the following items of work as indicated in Appendix.

3	WMM	1080 cum
4	DBM	720 cum
5	BC	224 cum

(usually 80% of the expected peak rate of construction)

- (h) The contractor or his identified sub-contractor should possess required valid electrical license for executing the building electrification works upto Rs.15 lakh and should have executed similar electrical works for a minimum amount **NIL** in anyone year.
- (i) The contractor or his identified sub-contractor should possess required valid license for executing the water supply/sanitary engineering works upto Rs.7.5 lakh and should have executed similar water supply/sanitary engineering works for a minimum amount **NIL** in anyone year.

B. Each bidder should further demonstrate:

- (c) availability (either owned or leased) of the following key and critical equipment for this work:

Based on the studies, carried out by the Engineer the minimum suggested major equipment to attain the completion of works in accordance with the prescribed construction schedule are shown in the Annexure-I.

The bidders should, however, undertake their own studies and furnish with their bid, a detailed construction planning and methodology supported with layout and necessary drawings and calculations (detailed) as stated in clause 4.3 (1) above to allow the employer to review their proposals. The numbers, types and capacities of each plant/equipment shall be shown in the proposals along with the cycle time for each operation for the given production capacity to match the requirements.

- (b)availability for this work of personnel with adequate experience as required; as per Annexure-II.

- (c)liquid assets and/or availability of credit facilities of no less than amount **Rs. 60 lakhs** (*Credit lines / letter of credit / certificates from Banks for meeting the funds requirement etc. - usually the equivalent of the estimated cash flow for 3 months in peak construction period.*)

C: To qualify for a package of contracts made up of this and other contracts for which bids are invited in the IFB, the bidder must demonstrate having experience and resources sufficient to meet the aggregate of the qualifying criteria for the individual contracts.


- a. Sub-contractors' experience and resources shall not 'be taken into account in determining the bidder's compliance with the qualifying criteria except to the extent stated in 4.5 (A) above.
- b. Bidders who meet the minimum qualification criteria will be qualified only if their available bid capacity is more than the total bid value. (Price level of the financial year 18-19)
